# Metamorphosis @ your library: Teen Summer Reading

## How to Participate

Sign up at the Teen Librarian's desk just outside the teen reading room beginning June 2 until June 15. She'll give you a Title Tracker —where you will write down what you're reading and the number of minutes you read—and you will also get a Program Passport.

## Why keep track of your minutes?

- Read **15 minutes** a day for **5 days** and keep track of it on your Title Tracker. We'll put your Title Tracker in a box and at the end of the week draw a winner for our weekly prizes.
- For every **2 hours** you read get one chance to enter the end-of-summer **GRAND PRIZE drawing**. The more you read, the more chances you get to win the grand prize!
- Weekly drawings will happen on Fridays during Late Night @ the Library. You do not have to be present to win! All Trackers must be turned in by 5pm each Friday to be eligible for the drawing.

## What counts as reading?

Books, newspaper articles, magazines, online articles, blogs, maps, listening to audio books, reading aloud to children, comic books, and graphic novels all count! So be sure to write down the title of everything you read on your Title Tracker.

## Passport

Your passport is key to earning more chances to enter in the end-of-summer GRAND PRIZE drawing. For each Teen Library Program you attend from June 16 to August 8 (excluding video game programs) you will receive a stamp in your passport.

## Attending

- **5 programs** gets you one extra chance.
- **10 programs** gets you two extra chances.
- **15 programs** gets you three extra chances.
- **20 programs** gets you four extra chances.
